- **SUBCONTRACTORS:** The Subcontractor Responsibility Certification shall be executed by the respective subcontractors of any tier upon request by the Contractor on this form and shall contain the same information and representations required in the Contractor Responsibility Certifications, including verification of apprenticeship qualifications as required by Chapter 13 Section 123.3.K, for each trade or classification of craft workers it will employ on the project.
